# Three Dimensions of Inequality

- Inequality in EMBODIED capital
- Inequality in NETWORK capital
- Inequality in PHYSICAL capital

# Definition of Corruption

## Demand Side

A public official...

...breaks the rules

(in return for a *reward*)

## Supply Side

A company or individual...

...pays a bribe

(in return for an *advantage*)

Both parties gain. Who loses?



# Three Dimensions of Corruption

- **State Capture**

Improper influence over policy **FORMATION**

- **Administrative Corruption**

Improper influence over policy **IMPLEMENTATION**

- **Disabling Democracy**

Improper influence over **MONITORING** institutions,  
checks and balances

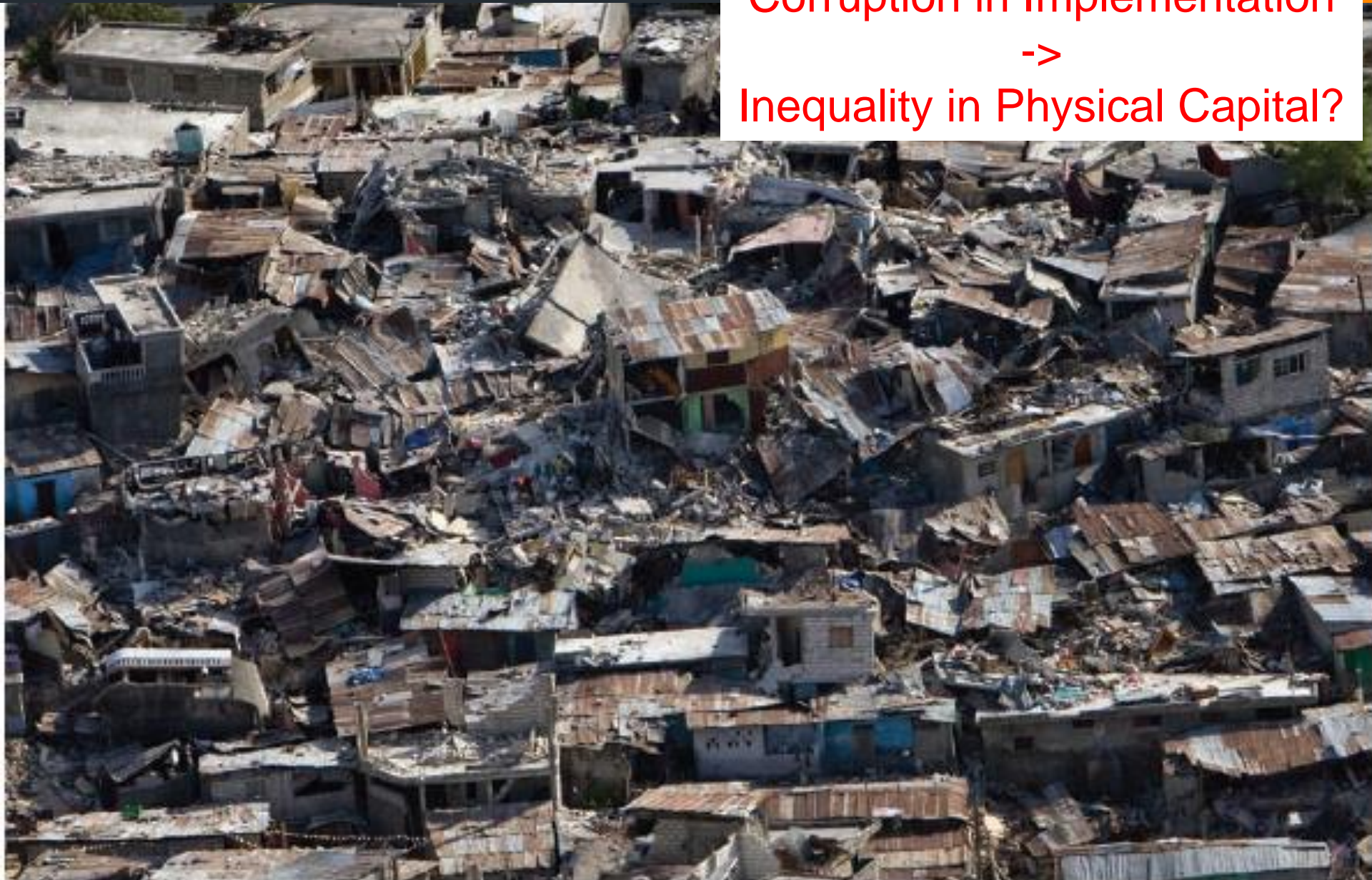
